

DOCUMENTS YOU NEED TO HELP COMPLETE THE **FAFSA**

If you don't have every one of these documents, that's okay. Come to a workshop with the documents that you have and that apply to you.



- Driver's license, if you have one
- Social Security card or number, if you have one
- Alien registration number, if you have one
- Your 2022 income information
- Parent 2022 income information
- Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) – yours or your parents'
- Your 2021 tax and parent tax information
- 2022 bank statements
- Any records of untaxed income such as welfare benefits, Social Security benefits, or child support payments
- List of colleges you are interested in attending

DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO FILL OUT THE **DREAM ACT** APPLICATION

List of paperwork you will need to provide, if it is relevant to your situation:

- W-2 forms and other 2022 records of income (if your parents have any)
- 2021 income tax returns (if your parents have any)
- Records of child support (if your parents have any)
- Records of student scholarships and fellowships included in your parents taxes
- Current bank statements (if applicable)
- Current investment records or business records if over 100 employees (if applicable)
- Current business and farm records (if applicable)
