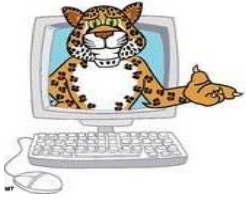


Welcome to Naviance!



We are pleased to introduce **Naviance Student**—
a web-based college and career planning and advising program for students and parents.

Naviance Student allows you to:

- **Get involved in the planning and advising process** – Build a resume, complete online surveys, and manage timelines and deadlines for making decisions about colleges and careers
- **Research colleges** – Compare GPA, standardized test scores, and other statistics to actual historical data from our school for students who have applied and been admitted in the past.
- **Research careers** – Research hundreds of careers and career clusters, and take career assessments
- **Create plans for the future** – Create goals and to-dos, and complete tasks assigned to you by the school to better prepare yourself for your future college and career goals

Naviance also lets us share information with you about upcoming meetings and events, local scholarship opportunities, and other resources for college and career information. You can also use the site to stay in communication with the counseling office.

⇒ Steps for registering with our school’s Naviance Student site:

1. Use an internet browser to connect to: <https://student.naviance.com/windsorhigh>
2. Locate the “**Are You New Here?**” box on the right and click on the “**I need to register link**”
3. Enter your **personal registration code** (below) in the **New User** box
4. Follow the on-screen instructions to create your own account. Remember to **write down** your new USER ID (email address) and PASSWORD!

5. Read the privacy statement and check the “**I accept**” box. **Click submit!**
6. You should now be on the **Windsor High’s Naviance Student Welcome** page.

You will be asked to create your own (using your personal email) during the initial activation process.

Required Tasks:

- **Submit/verify/update your personal email address.** This is essential for the school to communicate college updates, college visits and important bulletins.
- **Check messages regularly.** Don't miss out on important information, college visits and updates.

Naviance Features:

Naviance offers four main Tabs in addition to the Home Page: **College, Careers, About Me, My Planner** (not all tabs/features are available to all grades)

Cluster Finder (grades 9-12)	The Cluster Finder is an online questionnaire that helps students discover career clusters that are most interesting to them. Once a student completes the Career Cluster Finder, top matching career clusters are made available for review. Career Interest Profiler (grades 9-12)	The Career Interest Profiler is a career interest assessment for students based on Holland's interest codes. The Holland Codes is a system to classify jobs into job categories, interest clusters, or work personality environments. College Search (grades 10-12)	The College Search feature allows you to set search criteria to yield a list of colleges to explore. Click on the various tabs of the college profile (<i>general, financial aid, majors, and student life</i>) to learn more information. Colleges I am Thinking About (grades 10-12)	Colleges I am Thinking About allows you to create a list of Colleges you are interested in. Use " add to the list " to add colleges to your list. Use " compare me " to view WHS students that have been accepted to that college.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Colleges ▶ My Colleges ▶ Colleges I am Thinking About
Colleges I am Applying To (grade 12)	Colleges I am Applying To allows you to list all of the colleges you plan to apply to. Use " add to the list " to add colleges to your list. Use " compare me " to view WHS students that have been accepted to that college. Scattergrams (grade 10-12)	Scattergrams provides a graphical view of application outcomes (accepted, denied, waitlisted) at a college for recent WHS applicants using GPA and test scores. Upcoming College Visits (grade 10-12)	In addition to the HOME Page – you can access all of the scheduled Upcoming College Visits here and sign-up for the colleges that interest you. College Look-Up (grades 10-12)	College Look-Up provides information on thousands of colleges. In addition to general and admissions information, further data is presented on academics, cost/financial aid, student body characteristics, and extracurricular/athletic programs. College Resources (grades 9-12)	College Resources provides a list of links that can help you in your college and career search (such as military, financial aid, college athletics, etc.).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Colleges ▶ My Colleges ▶ College Resources
Test Scores (grades 10-12)	Edit, view, enter SAT, ACT, PSAT Test Scores . This information can be used to help complete applications, but also serves as data for many of our Naviance features.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Colleges ▶ Resources (left-hand side) ▶ Test Scores
Enrichment Programs (grades 9-12)	Enrichment Programs are listed by type (international, college-sponsored, high school-sponsored, & special interest) and also allows you to browse by special interest as well as search by keywords like the name, location, etc. Learn about program dates and costs (if available), any requirements, and the sponsor's website for more information and the application.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Colleges ▶ College Research ▶ Enrichment Programs
Scholarships (grade 11- 12)	Scholarship List: Gives WHS students access to local scholarships. National Scholarship Search: National Scholarship Search (hosted by Sallie Mae).
